

## **Call for Applications for Students SUMMER 2023**

The Eberswalde University for Sustainable Development – HNEE (Hochschule für nachhaltige Entwicklung Eberswalde) calls for applications to participate in the student-mobility program within the program “Transformation for a Sustainable Future in South-East-Asia (TranSEA)” during **summer term 2023**. The summer term starts on March 20th and ends on August 4th, 2023.

Apply now, if you are interested in completing a semester of study at HNEE in one of the following international (English language) study programs:

**M.A. Sustainable Tourism Management /Nachhaltiges Tourismusmanagement**

**M.A. Sustainable Entrepreneurship & Social Innovation** (\*some modules are taught in German, requiring C1 level; otherwise selected modules can be combined with modules from other study programs)

**M.Sc. Biosphere Reserves Management**

**M.Sc. Forestry System Transformation**

If selected to participate as an exchange student, you will receive a grant that assures the payment of travel costs and living costs in Germany, including health insurance coverage. It is expected of all students to arrive at least one week before the start of the term to complete the enrolment process and get established in Eberswalde.

### **Required documents:**

- Letter of intent (naming the study program you would like to study in, your motivation, what you expect to be the benefit of such an exchange for your student and professional life, and special engagements)
- Transcript of Record;
- Proof of enrolment (unofficial; an official copy is required later to complete admission);
- Certificate of English language proficiency (minimum B2 according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, CEFR)
- (Optional) Other relevant training certificates or recognition of scholastic achievement, social engagement, etc.

The first application phase is for financial support via a TranSEA scholarship ([www.hnee.de/TranSEA](http://www.hnee.de/TranSEA)). If accepted, applicants will receive further instructions for completing an application for enrolment at HNEE.
